SUMMARY:

The provisions of Regulation USF 3.0015 are out-of-date and have been repealed. The academic dishonesty and disruption of academic process definitions, punishments and procedures are posted in our undergraduate and graduate catalogs. Thus the Regulation has been amended accordingly and follows this summary:

Regulation Number: USF 3.0015

ACADEMIC DISHONESTY AND DISRUPTION OF ACADEMIC PROCESS: DEFINITIONS, PUNISHMENTS AND PROCEDURE.

The University of South Florida (University/USF) has established and will maintain Undergraduate and Graduate Catalogs available on line at www.usf.edu.

Such catalogs include academic procedures for Academic Disruption and Academic Dishonesty. The procedures set forth objective and fair processes to protect the individual rights of USF students and the mission of the University.
