The purpose of a structured and regulated parking system is to facilitate the activities of the University of South Florida, primarily instruction. The system of controlled and designated lots is designed to provide parking that will give students the ability to park close to their on-campus residence or to commute; faculty and staff access to classrooms and offices; and visitors the ability to participate in University activities. To meet this purpose, the University has developed parking regulations and parking brochures. ## Tampa Campus Proposed Parking Revisions

- **Parking Rates:** Tampa Campus parking rates increased by 20% for 2007-2008. The additional revenue will fund the debt service on additional parking garages. Parking Rates do not include applicable sales tax.
