Summary:

Florida Board of Governors Regulation 1.001 provides that “Each board of trustees is authorized to promulgate university regulations in accordance with the Regulation Development Procedure adopted by the Board of Governors,” (7-21-05). Such regulations must be consistent with law, and the regulations and strategic plan of the Board of Governors. The Regulation Development Procedure requires that the University Board of Trustees periodically review existing regulations to ensure they are current and consistent.

As required by the Florida Board of Governor’s Regulation Development Procedure, this is Notice of an amendment to Regulation USF 4.0102 reflecting adjustments for the 2013-2014 AY. The USF BOT approved the amounts of student activity, health, and capital improvement trust fund fees at the BOT’s March 2013 meeting. As occurs annually, this regulation implements these fees as well as tuition and other fees after the end of the legislative session and in time for the fall 2013 term.

AUTHORITY TO ADOPT/AMEND/REPEAL REGULATION: Art. IX, Sec. 7, Fla. Constitution; Fla. Board of Governors Regulations 1.001, 7.001 and 7.003.

Number: USF4.0102
Subject: Tuition and Fees

(1) **Tuition and Fees** ~~2012—2013~~ **2013 - 2014**. Tuition is defined as the basic fee assessed to students for enrollment in credit courses within the USF System. Out-of-state tuition includes the basic fee and out-of-state fees for enrollment in credit courses within the USF System. Tuition and associated fees consist of the following, depending on whether a student is in-state or out-of-state.

(a) Undergraduate

(2) Each student enrolled in the same undergraduate course more than twice, shall be assessed ~~\$120.24~~ \$122.00 per credit hour in addition to the fees outlined in section (a) above for each such course.

(3) Audit Registration Fees – Audit registration assures a course space for the student; however, no grade is awarded. The fee to audit a course is the same as the In-state tuition and other fees provided above.

(4) Registration for Zero Hours – Registration for zero hours provides for examinations, graduations, use of facilities, etc., when deemed appropriate by the USF System. The student is assessed In-state tuition and other fees provided above for one credit hour.

(5) An Excess Hour Fee shall be assessed to undergraduate students pursuant to Board of Governors Regulation 7.003(21).
