SUMMARY:

The Florida Legislature increased basic undergraduate tuition to \$95.67 and authorized State University Boards of Trustees to increase graduate, professional, out-of-state, Activity & Service, Athletic, and Health fees for the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year. The University of South Florida System will propose tuition and associated fee increases, as authorized, to the Board of Trustees and the Board of Governors.

New Global Experience Fee. The USF System is requesting approval of a new *Global Experience Fee*, pursuant to Chapter 2010-78, Laws of Florida, authorizing University Boards of Trustees to submit requests to establish new student fees to the Board of Governors. The *Global Experience Fee* proposal recommends setting a mandatory flat fee of \$10 per student, per semester (not tied to student credit hours) to expand the global student experience at USF. This fee will be financial aid eligible. The proposed *Global Experience Fee* is projected to generate \$920,000 in revenues in 2010-11 to support member campuses in directly developing and enhancing student success and to develop global perspectives that will be essential for the next generation of graduates. This fee was approved by the Executive Management Council of the University of South Florida and discussed with the President of the USF Student Government.
