## Summary

Florida Board of Governors Regulation 1.001 (9-16-10) provides that each Board of Trustees is authorized to promulgate University regulations in accordance with the Regulation Development Procedure adopted by the Board of Governors, (7-21-05). Such regulations must be consistent with law and the regulations and strategic plan of the Board of Governors.

This is notice that USF may propose a new "Academic Enrichment and Opportunity Fee" to the Board of Governors and to the Board of Trustees at the December 8, 2011 meeting. The fee is proposed at \$1.54 per credit hour. The "Academic Enrichment and Opportunity Fee" will enhance student academic experiences in research, community engagement, global education, cooperative education and career placement. The University will review the merits of the fee with the appropriate University officials and student groups.
