## NOTICE: PROPOSED AMENDED REGULATION

### Summary:

Florida Board of Governors Regulation 1.001 (9-16-10) provides that each Board of Trustees is authorized to promulgate university regulations in accordance with the Regulation Development Procedure adopted by the Board of Governors (7-21-05). Such regulations must be consistent with law, and the regulations and strategic plan of the Board of Governors. The Regulation Development Procedure also requires that the University Board of Trustees periodically review existing regulations to insure they are current and consistent.

The University of South Florida Educational Research Center for Child Development (ERCCD) was proposed and approved by the Florida Board of Governors (BOG) in 1984 to provide education and care for the children of graduate and undergraduate students, faculty, and other staff and employees of the University. BOG Regulations 7.003 and 10.004 authorize the University of South Florida to establish fees for child care and services provided by the Center. USF will submit a proposal for ERCCD fee increases to the December 1, 2011, Finance and Audit Workgroup for consideration at the December 8, 2011 Meeting of the Board of Trustees.

The University may also propose increases in existing Application and Orientation fees. The schedule of the proposed fees will be posted here as soon as they are available.
