(1) To apply for student financial aid, in addition to meeting all standards established by the granting agency the student must:

(a) Be admitted, or

(b) Once admitted, meet the Standard of Satisfactory Progress for financial aid recipients. The standard is based on Title IV Federal Financial Aid Regulations (Rev. 8-14-2008).

(c) On a timely basis, provide all requested documentation needed to complete their file.

(2) Awards are based on financial need and packaging policies established by University Scholarships & Financial Aid Services (USFAS). The University of South Florida System uses the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the federal need analysis for determining financial need. Applicants meeting the priority application dates, published in the USF Financial Aid Guide, are given priority consideration for need-based aid.

(3) If the student's application for financial aid is selected for verification by the Federal Government or the USFAS, eligibility for aid is contingent upon completion of the verification process.
